2009 Regina Rebels Spring Evaluation Camp

Hockey Regina Inc. (HRI) and the Regina Rebels Female Midget AAA Hockey Club invite you to participate in the 4th annual Regina Rebels Spring Camp. The camp will start the evening of Friday April 3rd, and continue throughout the weekend concluding on Sunday, April 5th, 2009.

All female hockey players born in 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, and 1996 are encouraged to attend.

This camp is a high performance development opportunity for players eager to improve and refine their hockey skills, and be evaluated by the Rebels coaching staff. It will also provide players with an opportunity to learn about the Rebels' Midget AAA program.

The camp will include three (3) games per team, and a skills session directed by the 2008/09 Rebels coaching staff as follows:

- o Doug Folk, Head Coach - played for the U of R, the U of S, and in the Saskatchewan Junior Hockey League (SJHL). Doug is a SHA High Performance Level I Coach, has instructed at many hockey schools, and is presently coaching with the SHA high performance (SaskFirst) female program.
- o Todd Dixon, Asst. Coach - former Technical Director for the SHA, and a coach of the U of R Cougars Women's Hockey Team. Todd played a key role in the establishment of the SaskFirst Female High Performance Program.
- o Laurie Montgomery, Asst. Coach - played NCAA Div. 1 hockey for the University of Minnesota-Duluth and the U of S. Laurie has served as an Assistant Coach with the Rebels the past three seasons.
- o Bob Brennan, Asst. Coach - coached in HRI from Novice through Midget AAA Pat Canadians for over 20 years. Has been a course instructor for the SHA, and coached in the SHA SaskFirst male program. Bob was involved at the grass roots level in the development of the Midget AAA Rebels program.
